### **Class Summary:**

This class is the third of four levels in the Information Technology Series. Incumbents perform professional IT duties in support of one or more areas. Programming - Specific responsibilities could include conducting user needs assessments and developing programming solutions; producing customized reports; providing technical support; and preparing monthly activity reports. Administrator - Specific responsibilities could include analyzing, designing, and implementing database solutions; developing and designing enterprise systems; monitoring system accessibility and storage; maintaining permissions, and providing high-level support to system users. Web - Specific responsibilities could include updating web pages and related content, and developing new web pages in accordance with user requirements. Project - Specific responsibilities could include planning and coordinating hardware and software projects; overseeing the design and evaluation of IT services; researching system solutions; and analyzing database integrity. The Information Technology Analyst is distinguished from the Information Technology Specialist in that it performs professional-level duties requiring the application of complex analysis and problem-solving skills.

### **Responsibilities:**

- Plans and implements the analysis of specific business problems and related technological solutions; defines requirements for creative, logical, and effective solutions; confers with applicable internal faculty and/or staff to determine feasibility of recommendations.
- Provides technical direction and support in information modeling concepts, data access, and reporting tools, which includes: designing and implementing in-house software applications; coordinating the extraction and transformation of data; identifying and interpreting technical information to develop data solutions; researching, analyzing, recommending, and implementing technological solutions.
- Conducts systems analyses and design studies; prepares concept and design specifications; programs, tests, and debugs applications and/or other technological systems.
- Prepares and reviews a variety of correspondence, reports, work orders, and/or related documents.
- Provides complex support and on-going troubleshooting assistance regarding complex information technology and/or hardware, software, and/or other related items; develops solutions to problems.
- Performs other duties of a similar nature or level.

### **Required Skills:**

- Analyzing processes, information, and data;
- Evaluating hardware and software applications;
- Installing, configuring and troubleshooting technological platforms, systems, databases, and/or software;
- Identifying, researching, troubleshooting, and resolving complex technical issues;
- Communicating technical information to a non-technical audience;
- Documenting procedures and preparing reports;
- Providing Customer Service;
- Maintaining operational records;
- Communication, interpersonal skills as applied to interaction with subordinates, coworkers, supervisor, the general public, etc. sufficient to exchange or convey information and to receive work direction
