

Vacancy Announcement Navajo Housing Authority Board of Commissioners

The Navajo Housing Authority (NHA) is seeking candidates for two (2) Board of Commissioner positions. The NHA is an entity of the Navajo Nation, which provides affordable housing to qualifying Navajo families. The available positions are:

- (1) Tenant Representative
- (1) Certified Public Accountant, Chartered Financial Analyst, or Executive Accountant

Board of Commissioner term is four (4) years.

Board Qualifications:

- a) Must be an enrolled member of the Navajo Tribe; and
- b) All Commissioners, at a minimum, shall have a formal post-high school education and employment experience in at least one working environment of a business operation, or architecture, or construction organization relevant to the activities of the Authority; and
- c) At least three (3) years of management or leadership experience in a corporate business, government or tribal organization. <u>NOTE</u>: Experience obtained in serving on the committees or other Board of Directors will not be considered; and
- d) Applicants shall not be members of the Navajo Nation Council or former employees of the NHA within the past three (3) years.

Interested applicants to submit required documents for consideration: Letter of interest, current resume (within the last 6 months), official college transcripts, professional certificates/degrees, Certificate of Indian Blood, and two (2) reference letters to:
