

**NOTICE OF REINSTATEMENT OF
RENTAL AND HOMEOWNERSHIP HOUSING PAYMENTS AND CERTAIN
ACTIVITIES**

Beginning June 2020, Navajo Housing Authority (NHA) will resume collecting Rental and Homeownership payments. In light of the current COVID-19 pandemic and reduction in work hours, the NHA recognizes that many of our participants may be experiencing issues with their monthly payments to NHA, therefore, rental payments for June will not be subject to any late fees.

In addition, NHA will also be postponing annual recertifications and home inspections until further notice. However, if your household income has increased or decreased by twenty percent (20%) or your family composition has changed please call the Housing Management Office and schedule an appointment for an interim recertification.

When we open the payment window, we will be open for credit card payments only, money order will be placed in the overnight drop box and NHA staff will post your payment and mail the receipt to your address on file. (Our payment windows will only accept credit card payments at this time. If paying with money orders, please utilize the overnight drop box, NHA staff will post your payment and mail the receipt to your address on file.) The overnight drop box may also be used to submit documents necessary to your composition changes and applications. We are ensuring all operations are in line with social distancing guidelines, as well as screening customers who are entering our offices.

We appreciate your understanding and patience with us as we prepare and adjust to the new environment. If you have any questions and concerns, please contact your local Housing Management offices.
